



## **SENIOR CHOIR - LAST MINUTE REMINDERS**

*Important information. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY*

We are nearly there! Our Festival Theatre performance is fast approaching. Please find below some important information to help things run smoothly on the day.

### **Festival Theatre Rehearsal: Thursday 10th September**

Before we get to concert day, we have our final rehearsal at the Festival Theatre this Thursday. This is the only opportunity for students to learn what is expected on the day as well as important safety information. It is very important that *Students attend this rehearsal. No school bags can be taken on this excursion. Students will need a drink bottle, lunch and a snack. Students will NOT be able to have lunch orders. Please note that we will not return to school until after normal pick up time.*

**Leave School:** 11:30am **Return to school:** approx. 4:15pm

### **Festival Theatre Performance: Sunday 13th September**

This is a big day for our students! Traffic and parking can be tricky around the theatre so please allow some extra time to get there. *Please remember that students meet at the theatre.*

**Arrive at the theatre:** 1:30pm

**Concert time:** 2:30pm

**Pick up time:** 4:35pm

### *Parking*

The train is a great option and very close to our drop off and pick up location. The Riverbank or Exhibition carparks are a good options if you are driving. These are accessible from North Terrace and Morphett Street.

### *Drop off and pick up:*

The Festival Theatre area will be EXTREMELY BUSY on the day. The attached map shows our drop off and pick up location. Please drop students at the location at the designated time and enjoy some time at the theatre before the concert begins. Unfortunately there is not a lot of room for you to wait at the line up area with us. To make things a little easier, please consider the following:

### *Before being dropped off:*

- Students have been to the toilet (they can use the toilets in the foyer)
- Students do not have a mobile phone on them
- Students with asthma have their puffer on them (if needed)
- Students are in correct dress (see below)

### *Dress for the performance*

- Round neck (bright) coloured t-shirt (no patterns, no black/pastel/white/fluoro colours),
- Enclosed shoes
- Dark pants or shorts (school pants are fine)
- No jewellery except studs/sleepers
- Hair needs to be worn away from faces.
- No makeup, glitter spray etc.

### *After the performance:*

After the performance, everyone will be excited! Unfortunately it will also be very busy. If possible, please send only one adult to collect students from the designated spot (same location as drop off). There is no hurry to get back to our spot. It takes a little while for us to get off the stage and out of the theatre. Please be patient at this time and remember that **ALL STUDENTS MUST BE MARKED OFF THE ROLL BEFORE THEY LEAVE.**
