Dear parent/caregiver,

Today the Premier announced a 7-day statewide lockdown starting at 6.00pm tonight (Tuesday 20 July).

Only the children of essential workers and vulnerable children will be able to attend school if necessary. OSHC, before and after school, will be offered for Wednesday 21 July, however we will advise within the next 24 hours if this service will operate for the remaining school days of the lockdown.

A skeleton staff will provide supervision but not a learning program for tomorrow. We will be offering a remote learning program from tomorrow and more details will be sent from your classroom teacher. If your child needs to attend, we will be here for them.

All students have been asked to take home school laptops/devices, books and anything else they need to continue their learning from home.

All students will require access to a device with an internet connection and browser to enable them to access home learning from Thursday 22/7/21. This can be a tablet, iPad, desktop, laptop or any other device that meets these requirements. Please advise your child's classroom teacher ASAP if you require support in accessing a device at home.

Your child's class teacher will be in touch regarding any requirements for home learning. This will be communicated via the class Facebook page. If you require support to access communication from the school, please contact us on 8322 6422.

More information on learning programs will be provided later this week, as we work our way through the new COVID-19 Directions.

All South Australians are making sacrifices to ensure our community remains as safe as possible. We appreciate that this is a significant undertaking for you and your family. Your child's teacher, our support staff and I are here to support you where we can.
