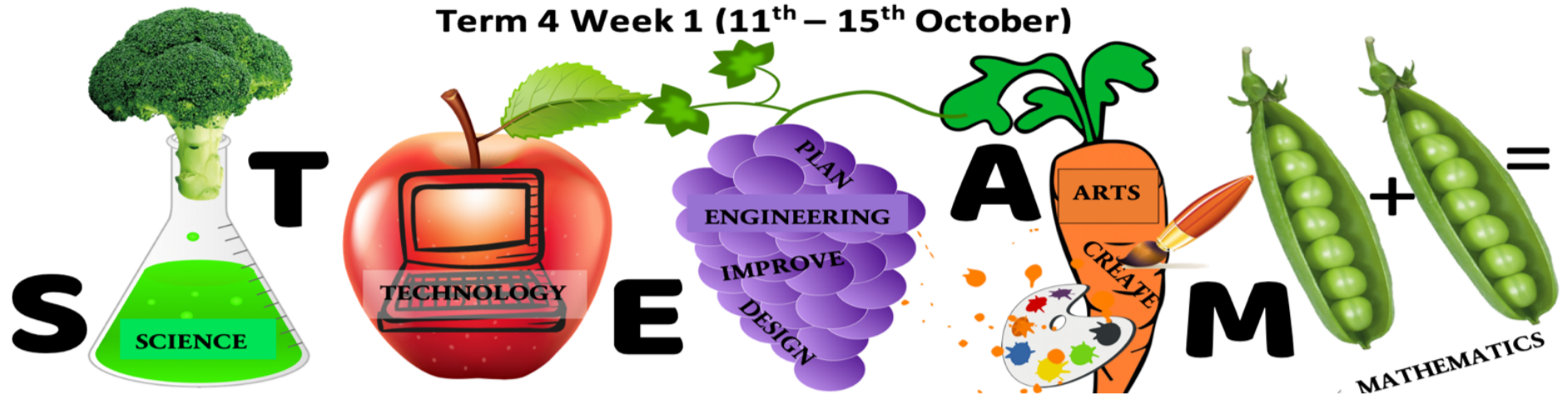


STEAM WEEK 2021!
